

LES PLATES PIERRES 2011 Extra-brut

« Les Plates Pierres » is a plot of vineyard which has been managed by the Grumier family through several generations.

Settled on a limestone and clay soil, it was entirely replanted in 1990 and 1991, this large vineyard (1,40 ha) provides wines of a high aromatic purity. We are keen to better express this wonderful soil with an alternative winegrowing system with cover planting and a work of the soil under the row.

We also bring to this bottle the grape variety of the vineyard with a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

This wine is from a very great year and is developed for the ageing. Try to taste it with a « Turbo rôti aux girolles » or a « poularde Bresse *».
